- Do all curriculum areas offer opportunities to recognise the impact of our decisions and lifestyle on the lives of others e.g. deforestation, buying products that use exploited labour, ethical considerations in science?
- How does teaching about death and bereavement help pupils to face loss in their lives?

- How do you initiate and sustain support for local or international charities that is motivated by genuine empathy and compassion?
- Are there any principles that can be followed to ensure that tough decisions are made and communicated compassionately?
